

## TEAM ORLANDO STUDENT DAY

### RULES AND CRITERIA FOR DEMONSTRATING PROJECTS

Schools must submit their proposal(s) to the National Center for Simulation (NCS) for the Modeling and Simulation (M&S) projects they wish to demonstrate in the Central Florida Research Park on 25 February 2019.

Demonstration rules are as follows:

- 1) Students must be enrolled in a Florida high school or technical school.
- 2) Each Project Team shall not exceed 6 students.
- 3) Students should be taking or have taken courses in modeling, simulation, animation, gaming, computer science or visualization
- 4) M&S Projects can be in any of the following application areas: military, space, medical/health, entertainment, education, transportation, environment, energy, science, homeland security, history or art.
- 5) Each Project Team must have a faculty advisor who will accompany the team to the facility and remain with the students at the event.
- 6) Project Teams will display a poster that has the following information: Project Name, School, School District, Project Objective, Team Members, Significant Features of the Project Hardware/ Software Used, Project Impact.
- 7) Project Teams will bring their own equipment and display tables. Power is available.
