Why is Heart of Florida United Way Focusing on Veterans?

- 110,000 veterans call Central Florida home.
- 44% of veterans who served after 9/11 report difficulty readjusting to civilian life.
- Veterans report difficulties finding employment, accessing and completing education.

What is Mission United?

- Mission United is a community collaboration that will provide veterans with a central point of community support, ensuring that service members and their families are never more than two steps from the help they need.
- Mission United will focus on creating systemic change in the areas of education, employment, and legal services for veterans.



Employment

- Increase the number of veteran hire rates in Central Florida through employer education and partnerships.



Education

- Increase the number of veterans accessing and completing vocational training or college education, leading to higher employability skills.



Legal Services

- Provide counsel and advice to veterans about legal problems, like eviction, foreclosure, accessing public benefits, family law or bankruptcy. Offer assistance with finding a lawyer, if necessary.
