Before the Expo

Students who have a strong desire to be selected for an internship should spend time learning about the employers who will be attending the expo. Take time to review all employers who will be in attendance. Don't count out any employer based upon the types of positions you think they may offer. For example, you may believe only accounting or finance organizations hire accountants. Remember that lots of organizations need accountants! Don't dismiss governmental agencies, non-profits and other business sector employers.

After you've done some preliminary research, decide which employers you will focus on. Learn as much about the organization as possible so that you're able to articulate why you believe you would be a good fit. Know enough so that you're able to ask insightful questions. Remember that there are a lot of wonderful students out there and you will need to make the case for why you are the right student for the internship.

At the Expo

Make a Plan

Employers will not be impressed if you seem to have stumbled across them at the expo. Look at the list of employers who will be there, choose which ones look like the best fit for you and come prepared to talk with those employers first.

Be prepared to confidently introduce yourself, giving your best handshake, showing enthusiasm and making eye contact with the employer. Have a quick pitch, an "elevator speech," no more than two minutes long, with information about yourself—general background, leadership experience, and what you would bring to an organization. Don't just think about what you'll say—actually practice it out loud so you sound confident and ready when you're at the expo.

Plan a Few Questions

Bring questions to ask about each organization to show that you did your research.

Dress Appropriately

Business attire is a must. Employers will be actively seeking interns so you should come ready to put your best foot forward. Please avoid jeans, t-shirts and other casual attire.

Bring Several Copies of your Resume

Be sure to bring enough copies of your resume to share with multiple people for each position that interests you. Don't forget to take time to make sure your resume is current and without any errors.

There are Benefits to Paid and Unpaid Internships

Don't pass up an opportunity simply because it is unpaid. Be sure to consider the experience you will gain within an organization before making a final decision. Sometimes unpaid positions can lead to paid ones so let opportunity be your guide!

Don't be Afraid to Courteously Decline a Position

While at the expo, you may realize that a position isn't right for you. Maybe it's too far away and you won't be able to get reliable transportation. Maybe you aren't as interested in the internship after learning all the details. It's okay to graciously decline an offer. Try saying something like, "This sounds like a great opportunity and I appreciate you sharing the details about the position with me. I'm afraid I may not be the best candidate but I appreciate your time."



After the Expo

Organize your Internship Leads

Since you probably networked with several different employers, it's important to stay organized and keep track of all your potential job leads. You'll want to create a document that keeps track of all the representatives you spoke with. Make sure to include their business card information and any notes you may have jotted down about your discussion.

Follow up with Employers

At the career expo you were probably gathering as many business cards as you could, and now it's important to follow up with the employers contacts you met. Send an email or thank you letter to those employers that provided their contact information.

Make sure your follow-up is well written and uses proper grammar. If you had a good conversation, make note of something you discussed at the expo. In addition:

- Tie your skill sets to match the open position
- · Let employers know you are excited to pursue the position and work for the company
- Tell employers what sets their company apart from others
- Express your appreciation for their time and input at the expo

Reflect on your Experience at the Internship Expo

It is important to reflect on how you managed yourself so you can prepare and make any improvements at the next expo. Ask yourself:

- How well did I prepare for the expo?
- Do I feel like I networked well?
- Did I give my elevator speech?
- What went well?
- What would I do differently?
- Did I learn something about myself or a potential employer?




