- Applicants, either freshman, masters, or doctorial, must be full-time students.
- Applicants must hold a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

- 2. A 500-word letter from you that briefly introduces yourself, describes your educational and career aspirations, and justifies why you should be the recipient of this scholarship. Justification can include eligibility as described above, financial need, GPA, community work, or any other relevant purpose.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a previous or current professor and the other from an M&S industry professional.
- 4. Copies of your current high school or college transcripts.
- 5. Your current resume.
